	Question	Answer
1.	- Dimensions of field (under refabricated structure-Balloon) and most common type of sports that will be performed?	Dimensions of the field are specified in the Annex II+III technical specifications + technical offer and they are 24x45m. Purpose of the balloon is mainly for exhibition and cultural events, and then for different kinds of sports activities.
2.	- Requirements for size of free space around sport field (under refabricated structure-Balloon), need for sport bleachers (if yes, then type, size dimensions)?	Technical documentation of the tenderer should provide the best solution. If technical documentation envisaged bleachers, it can be considered as an advantage, as long as other requirements are fulfilled. Type and size of the bleachers are left to the tenderer's choice.
3.	- Specification of all required additional buildings, and positioning (are they under the refabricated structure-Balloon or independent)?	In the Annex II+III technical specifications + technical offer it is stated that the City of Pozarevac plans to purchase a balloon with two toilets and two changing rooms, situated inside the balloon.
4.	- You have stated in technical specification " Coverage of the sports hall: material should be PVC polyester canvas, weight 650-680gr/m2"...is it allowed to offer similar material with better quality?	It is allowed to offer similar material with better quality if the tenderer provides evidence/specification on which the Commission can determine the quality of the material.
5.	- Could you provide more information regarding "Prepare base/ground for setting up the tensile sports hall according to the technical documentation"?	The supplier should construct the foundation for the sports Hall with all works specified and according to the technical documentation of the supplier.
