Recorded on August 23rd, 2018 at General Hospital Pozarevac, on the occasion of the second information meeting and site visit related to the implementation of project Supervision services for Construction works for New (Unfinished) Hospital building - Phase II for strategic project „Romania-Serbia joint initiative against cancer in cross-border region: improved diagnosis and treatment of malignant tumors - ROSECAN”

The informative session started at 11.00 h.

From the side of the General Hospital Pozarevac, Mr. Danko Nikolic has opened the informative session of the meeting by greeting all participants and explaining that this project is funded from the European Union, though INTERREG IPA Cross-border Cooperation Romania - Serbia Programme. He added that the whole process will be carried out in line with the European standards and EU tender procedures.



Mrs. Lela Ruzic explained that this is very important project for the General Hospital Pozarevac in order to obtain adequate facilities that will allow the Hospital to extend their capacities and finish Phase II of reconstruction. The reconstruction understands renovation from the 1st floor to the top (3rd floor) of the building and it is expected that the premises will be fully compliant with the needs of the General Hospital Pozarevac.

Then she thanked the attendees for coming and elaborated on the content and presentation of the Tender, making reference to the published instruction to tenderers. Reference was made to the foreseen timetable, main documents to be delivered in the bidding phase as well as the main selection criteria, validity of the offers, opening of the tender procedures etc.

Finally, it was emphasized that this is just an information meeting and that all the answers which would be given now are exclusively informative, as well as that the official questions and answers will be given in writing. She explained that the communication for this tender and the documentation will have to be English.

The official answers to any new questions or those raised during the meeting will be published by the Contracting Authority as specified in the Instructions to Tenderers. The attendees went for site visit of the building, starting from the basement up to the roof.

The Site Visit started at 11.45h, where all participants visited the premises of the new building.
