## One potential tenderer asked:

- 1.If it is a partner of a joint venture/consortium (i.e. not the lead member) it must be able to carry out at least 10% of the <u>contract works</u> using its own means.
- In the case of the Designer, who is not actually involved in the execution of the works, is it compulsory that he also meets the requirement of at least 10%?
- 2. Following the Clarification 3 work execution posted by you, stating that The execution of the works Placing under safe conditions of the Sinmihaiu Hydro-knot comprises the stages 2.1, 3, 4.

How about the demolition works from stage 1? Are they part of the Execution or not?

## **Banat River Basin Administration reply:**

1. Yes, if even the designer is a partner he is required to have at least 10% according to the special conditions.

If the designer has less than 10% involvement in the contract then he can be a subcontractor.

- 2. Stage 3 3.1. Within the stages 3 and 4 at points 3.1, 3.3, 4.3 the demolition works were mentioned as follows:
- 3.1. Works for placing to dry the lock: extracting the piles and moving them upstream and downstream
  - demolition of the earth cofferdam for putting to dry the dam
  - 3.3. Disaffecting and transport of the temporary bridge
- Stage 4-4.3. Realizing of a scaffold for boarding and landing, upstream of the existing discharge sill, which will be demolished after works ending
