

**One potential tenderer asked:**

1. We are concerning about our correct meaning of term contract works used in relation with carry out percentage in:

If it is the lead member of a joint venture/consortium it must be able to carry out at least 50% of the contract works using its own means.

If it is a partner of a joint venture/consortium (i.e. not the lead member) it must be able to carry out at least 10% of the contract works using its own means.

**Question:**

Percentages 50% and 10% are applied to total amount of contract (which is 100%) or is applied to part contracted work by each member (lead or partner)?

**Banat River Basin Administration reply:**

If he is the main partner he has to have 50% of the contracted part, if he is not the main partner he has to have 10% of the contracted part.
